School Learning

Literacy

This week we are making predictions about our new book for the term, 'The Firework-Maker's Daughter'. We are also learning the spelling rules for the prefixes 'un', 'dis' and 'mis'.

Maths

In maths we are looking at multiplication. We are focusing on how we can multiply 3 numbers together, factor pairs and using our mathematical knowledge to find efficient ways of solving problems.
