

<u>Summer Term – Year 1</u> <u>2022/2023</u>

Reading

In reading we will look at a range of fiction and non – fiction texts to answer questions focused on using inference skills to deduce characters' thoughts and feelings and help explain actions. We will focus on reading with expression and understanding how the different punctuation helps us to make the story more interesting. We will be learning how to use our comprehension skills to retrieve information from the text.

Writing

In writing this term, we will be continuing to work on our letter formation and presentation of our books. We will be joining two sentences with the word 'and' and using the word 'because' as well as adding exclamation marks, question marks and time adverbials to our writing. We will be using the books 'The Tale of Peter Rabbit' by Beatrix Potter and 'Lost in the Toy Museum' by David Lucas.

Maths

In maths, we will be learning about the 2, 5, and 10 times tables and will be sharing different amounts equally. We will be learning about fractions and how to cut shapes in halves and quarters. We will then move on to learning about numbers up to 100, as well as money and time.

Geography

In Geography, the children will be learning about where different significant people came from around the world and adding them to a Key Stage 1 World Map.

Science

In Science we will be learning about Plants and Seasons. As part of this we will be growing our own vegetables from seeds and watching how they change over the term.

RE

We will be looking at what makes some places sacred.
We will also be looking at Fid.

Computing

We will continue to learn how to use technology safely and responsibly. We will also learn how to do coding and how to create a simple spreadsheet.

History

In History we will be learning about significant people that have had an impact on our lives today. We will be looking at Mary Seacole, Florence Nightingale, William Caxton and Tim Berners-Lee among others.

Art

We will be focusing on line, shape and pastels. We will be looking at the artist Ashley Jackson and learning about creating our own watercolour landscapes.

DT

We will be learning about wheels and axles and will create our own vehicle with moving wheels.

Music

In music we will be covering the units about Famous People and Banana Rap.

PE

In PE we will be learning about Tennis and Cricket. We will also have the 'Elite' coaches to teach some of our sessions as well as Fitness Fortnight.

Homework will be sent out on a Monday and is to be returned by the following Monday.
