Earning house points for our house teams by following our golden rules:

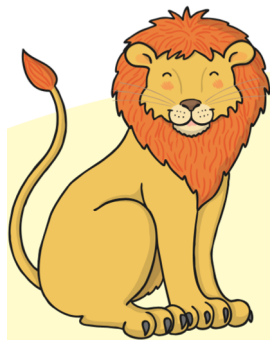
Keep being honest
