

Covid-19: Actions you can take to help

Please do not send your child to school if they are showing symptoms OR someone in their household is showing symptoms. Please let school know if your child is not attending. The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
- Most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms.

<u>Arrange a test</u> if you or your child develops symptoms. Inform school of the results. If the test is positive, follow <u>guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection</u>, and engage with the NHS Test and Trace process. If you have any of the main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), get a test as soon as possible. Stay at home until you get the result. Please contact school if you need any help.

Half Term:

Where children test positive for COVID-19 during half-term, having developed symptoms more than 2 days since being in school, no action is needed. Staff, young people, parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace. However, where pupils or staff test positive having developed symptoms **within 2 days** of being in school you may be identified as a close contact and be advised to self-isolate.

Please contact <u>admin@newton-hill.org.uk</u> if your child tests positive within 2 days of being at school. Please use 'Positive Covid Case' in the subject line. Only Covid related emails will be responded to.
