Expansion: 2017/2018

I am sure you have all seen the new fencing that has been put up in the playground, this is for phase 2 of our expansion to build 6 new classrooms. It will also involve obtaining the additional field and eventually, over summer 2018, changes to the school hall. This is a very exciting time for the school; however, there will be a few changes to school:

- 1. Y1 and Y2 children will access the school using the hall fire doors. Staff will meet children at the door as usual. Children will also be dismissed at the end of the day from these doors.
- 2. As part of the playground is now out of use, we have made changes break times and lunchtimes. KS1 and KS2 will now have separate breaks in the morning and the afternoon.
- 3. The new perimeter fencing for our new field has been delayed, work is due to start imminently. This will also involve removing the wall once the perimeter fence has been put up. Once this work commences, the playground will be out of use for a short time and extra care will need to be taken. When this work starts the gate near Year 5/6 entrance will stay locked and we would ask all parents to follow the path to our EYFS playground.

We will keep you updated as phase 2 develops. Thank you for your suggestions and patience at this time as we make changes to our normal school routines. School Attendance Matters



Our school attendance is improving but it is still below national. We need your help to improve our attendance.

Any absence from school is detrimental to a child's education and progress. It disrupts learning, routines and progress.

The link between attendance and attainment in school is clear. The more a pupil is in school the more they increase their opportunity to fulfil their potential.

If your child's attendance is under 95%, they are missing at least <u>two weeks</u> of learning time a year. If their attendance is at 90%, they are missing <u>four weeks</u>. If your child's attendance falls below 90% it is classed as persistent absence. Punctuality is important, if a child arrives 15 minutes late each school each day, they lose almost 2 weeks of education a year. If your child is late after registers close this is marked as a lost session. You will need to complete a <u>Holiday Request Form</u> if a holiday is to be taken in term time. Once this has been received you will then receive a letter from school regarding the absence. As a school we pass all requests for holidays to the Education Welfare Service. You will receive a letter/penalty notice from the EWO regarding your term time holiday.

Holiday Request Forms are available from the school office.
