



Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a lovely first week back at Newton Hill and it has been really nice to be able to welcome you back on the school premises once again. We are all looking forward to returning to some kind of normality to school life. Thank you for your cooperation with drop off and pick up – lining up at the designated markers really helps class teachers to be able to dismiss the children safely at the end of the day. We have also been super impressed about how the children have been lining up independently to enter school each morning.

Just a reminder that ball games are not permitted before school in the playground and we ask that you supervise your children before the gates open and whilst you are on school premises. Please encourage your child/children to follow our golden rules and keep everyone safe. Any children using bikes/scooters must dismount at the school gates (this includes all younger siblings). Also, please be respectful to our neighbours while waiting at the gate.

We ask that you still remain vigilant as Covid has not disappeared by any means and we have already had a positive case in school this week. As you know, all track and trace will now be carried out by the NHS. Please continue to monitor your child/children and if they are unwell do not send them to school – if you are unsure, please contact school for advice.
