And so, to 2021/2022.....we are (as I am sure you are) hoping for a different kind of year!

In September, schools will no longer be expected to have 'bubbles' for groups of children in school. This means in September there will be no staggered start times and finish times. We will keep some groupings at lunchtime and playtimes at least for the first half term and Newts will continue to operate with an earlier finish time of 5:15pm on Fridays.

This does not mean that COVID has gone away — we all still need to remain vigilant and protect each other as much as we can. With this in mind, we ask that all parents and carers remain a safe distance from school staff and other parents and that personal space is respected when dropping off and picking up. There are children and adults who are vulnerable in our community and we need to work together to keep everyone safe. Some staff may continue to wear face coverings and visors in school and when speaking to parents/carers.

As a school we will have an outbreak management plan in place should there be an outbreak of positive cases at school – we will of course follow government guidelines should this happen.

In September, the perimeter school gates at East Street and Fourth Avenue gates will open just before 8:50 with the doors to school opening at 8:50am so that your child/children can immediately enter school. The main entrance on <u>Leeds Road</u> will not be opened as an entrance to school at this time and the gate will be locked. This gate can still continue to be used for children to access Newts before and after school.

No ball games are permitted before school in the playground and we ask that you supervise your children before the gates open and whilst you are on school premises. Please encourage your child/children to follow our golden rules and keep everyone safe. Any children using bikes/scooters must dismount at the school gates (this includes all younger siblings).

At the end of the day the gates will be open at 3:10 for EYFS/KS1 pick up at 3:15pm and KS2 pick up at 3:20pm. Gate will not be opened earlier due to the premises being used of outdoor learning and PE etc. Children will no longer be collected or walked to the perimeter gates by school staff, you will have to enter the premises to collect and drop off your child. There will be designated waiting areas for each class – this will enable a quicker dismissal at the end of the day. We ask that you leave the premises as soon as you have dropped off and picked up.

In September it is expected that the children will walk into school by themselves — our Nursery and Reception children have done this exceptionally well this year and this is something that we will be continuing. Please talk to your children about walking into school and the EYFS unit independently. Staff will be there to greet the children on Tuesday 7th September and to help you find your way. The children have been shown where they will come into school.

Where to drop off and pick up:

Class	Drop off/pick up point *There will be signs to help you locate your drop off/pick- up point.
Nursery	11:50 You will need to use the main entrance to collect, please follow the path to Nursery and in the EYFS Playground. 3:15 Please wait at the EYFS gate which leads into the main playground. *30 Hours - please collect from the main entrance as already explained.
Reception	Please wait at the EYFS gate which leads into the main playground.
Year 1	Please line up along the edge of the playground – opposite Nursery window.
Year1/2	Under the new canopy in the main playground.
Year 2	At the right-hand side of the hall – please wait at the end of the green fence.
Year 3	Under the new canopy in the main playground.
Year 4	Along the curved path near the green fence – Fourth Avenue gate
Year 5 and Year 6	Along the straight path – Fourth Avenue gate.

Positive Covid Cases:

If there is a positive case in school from September, close contacts will be identified via NHS Test and Trace and education settings will no longer be expected to undertake contact tracing.

Class Email System:

Please note that during the summer holidays, class emails and the admin email will be closed down until Monday 6^{th} September. New class email addresses will be issued in the new year.

If there needs to be any changes to our reopening plans for September we will contact you on Monday 6th September (this is an INSET day and school is closed to all children).
