This week in class we are:

English:

• Learning to write a recount. We are using time conjunctions to sequence the order of the events e.g. first, then, after that etc.

Maths:

• Learning about subtraction and finding how many are left.

Topic:

• Talking about and discussing what bullying is. We are going to look at different scenarios and explore the best choices they can make as individuals.

This week at home:

English:

- Read every day to a family member and talk about what has happened in the story.
- Practise forming your letter formations. Make sure your letters are sitting on the line and are facing the right way. These can be practised in your homework book.
- Practise the spellings that are stuck in your book.

Topic:

• Over the term the children can make and prepare their own project about toys or materials. This can be presented in whichever way they would like. Your child will then get the opportunity to present their project to the class once it's completed. E.g. They could bring in a toy then talk about what materials it's made from and how it works. With help they could make an information leaflet or present their ideas on a PowerPoint.
